C. BOARD DISCUSSION

1. Chesapeake Bay Preservation Ordinance – Resource Management Area Buffers

Mr. Scott Thomas, Environmental Director, Mr. Mike Woolson, Environmental Division Senior Planner, and Mr. Paul Stern from Center for Watershed Protection gave a presentation on the revisions to the Resource Management Area buffers in the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Ordinance.

Discussion was held about criteria that would designate impervious cover in the Resource Management Area (RMA) proposal and the structures that may be built within a defined buffer width. The Board and staff discussed flexibility in the outer zone, and the use of the term buffer versus the term setback. Discussion was held about potentially designating an allowed percentage of impervious cover in the outer zone and what properties would be affected by the grandfathering and vesting rules.

Discussion was held about the priority of water quality and wildlife areas, as well as stormwater management and how the current zoning would affect the water quality in the watersheds. The Board and staff discussed the buffer requirements of similar localities and areas, as well as by-right cluster development and protection of rural lands. Discussion was held about impervious surfaces allowed as exceptions in the outer zone and permitted agricultural and forestal structures.

Discussion was held about notification of property owners and staff was directed to provide notification appropriately to RMA-affected parcels. The Board directed staff to bring a public hearing on this ordinance amendment forward on April 8, 2008.

CERTIFICATION OF CLOSED MEETING


