SUBJECT: Revisions to the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement – Chesapeake, Hampton, Newport News, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Suffolk, Virginia Beach, James City County, Williamsburg, York County, and the Town of Smithfield

---

In 1990 the Cities of Chesapeake, Hampton, Newport News, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Suffolk, Virginia Beach, and the County of James City adopted a mutual aid agreement beneficial to regional law enforcement. In 1997, the City of Williamsburg and the County of York were included in the agreement. In the winter of 2002, the members of the Hampton Roads Chiefs Association decided that the agreement should be updated. To this end, the proposed agreement was recommended with the following changes:

1. Inclusion of the Town of Smithfield;
2. Paragraph No. 3, deletion of reference to the TECAP radio system; and
3. Paragraph No. 10, changed to reflect current State Codes.

Staff recommends adoption of the attached resolution be authorized to bring the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement up-to-date.
