 SUBJECT: Appropriation of Insurance Proceeds - \$55,804

On July 6, 2008, a thunderstorm caused a large tree branch to fall and damage the Vermillion House at Jamestown Beach Campground. An insurance claim in the amount of \$65,804 was filed with the Virginia Association of Counties Insurance Pool. Recovery was obtained based on an appraised estimate for \$55,804 (\$10,000 property deductible).

Attached is a resolution that appropriates these proceeds toward the repair of the damages to the Vermillion House. Funds will be used as follows:

Low bid from RRMM Construction	\$40,798
Emergency tree removal	5,500
Emergency repairs	7,200
Insurance account balance for continuing temporary repairs	<u>2,306</u>
Total:	<u>\$55,804</u>
