

SUBJECT: Contract Award – James City/Williamsburg Community Center Pool Pump Replacement – \$135,142

The existing pool pump at the James City/Williamsburg Community Center is approximately 22 years old and is approaching the end of its useful life. New advances in pump technology include much improved efficiency, safety, accessibility, and water cleaning and disinfection. Replacement of the existing pump will bring the benefits of these advances to Community Center patrons and County staff.

A Request for Proposals (RFP) for the replacement of the pool pump at the James City/Williamsburg Community Center was advertised. The following four firms submitted proposals: Aquatic Construction, Coastal Services and Technologies, Greenland Enterprises, Inc., and Powell Aquatics, LLC. Staff members from Parks and Recreation, General Services, and Purchasing evaluated the proposals and determined Coastal Services and Technologies was the most fully qualified firm and its proposal best suited the County's needs as defined in the RFP. A price of \$135,142 was negotiated with Coastal Services and Technologies for this project.

The FY 2009 Capital Improvements budget includes \$140,000 for this purchase.

Staff recommends approval of the attached resolution.
