



SUBJECT: Grant Award – Department of Criminal Justice Services – \$53,475

The James City County Police Department anticipates receipt of a grant award from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) in September 2009 to continue the position of its full-time Gang Investigator retroactive to July 1, 2009. Because of a delay in DCJS receiving notification of its award of grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, there has been a delay in DCJS announcing the availability of continuation funding and grant awards to localities.

The anticipated grant award of \$43,720 (DCJS share \$32,790; County Match \$10,930) is to be used towards the salary and partial fringe benefits to continue the position of the full-time Gang Investigator. Additional costs for this position in the amount of \$9,755 include estimated overtime and additional costs for fringe benefits. The grant match and the additional costs associated with the position have already been budgeted in the County's FY 2010 Grant Match account. The total project cost is \$53,475.

Staff recommends adoption of the attached resolution to appropriate funds and to continue the position.
