



SUBJECT: Grant Award – Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant – \$54,793

Through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 - Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG), the James City County Police Department has received an allocation of \$54,793. Additionally, the Department has received information that the pending grant request to continue the Gang Resistance Education and Training (GREAT) program will not be awarded. Because the Department is vigilant in its efforts to fight gangs and educate the citizens, adults, and children alike on the subject of gangs, the Department has chosen to use this JAG allocation towards the salary and fringe benefits of the GREAT Officer in order that the program can continue.

Additional funds necessary to pay the salary and fringe for this position in the amount of \$5,036 are available in the County's Grant Match account. While executing the budget process for FY 2010, the James City County Police Department anticipated the receipt of continuation funding for the GREAT program and budgeted funds toward the match.

Staff recommends adoption of the attached resolution to accept the grant award, appropriate funds, and continue the position.
