ARTICLE II. SEPTIC TANK CLEANERS

Sec. 17-8. License required.

No person shall engage in the business of removing the contents of privies or septic tanks in the county without first having obtained from the commissioner of the revenue, or his duly appointed representative, a license to engage in such business. (11-1-54, ' 1)

Sec. 17-9. Conditions precedent to issuance of license.

No license will be issued under this article until the equipment to be used and the manner and places of disposal of the contents of privies and septic tanks have been approved by the county health officer or his representative. The equipment, to be approved, must be capable of holding and transporting the contents of privies and septic tanks in a sanitary manner and without spillage. The places of disposal must be free from any chance of such contents contaminating any food or water supply or stream and must not be on any property without the owner's written consent. The manner of disposal must be such that flies, animals and fowl will not have access to such contents. (11-1-54, ' 1)

Sec. 17-10. Annual license tax imposed.

There is hereby levied and assessed an annual license tax of \$50.00, not proratable, upon each licensee under this article. (1-11-54, ' 1)

ARTICLE III. SEPTIC TANKS

Sec. 17-11. Permit required.

Before commencement of construction of a private wastewater disposal system, the owner(s) shall first obtain a written permit from the county code compliance office. The application for such permit shall be made on a form furnished by the code compliance office, and shall include written approval by the county health department, as well as any plans, specifications, and other information as are deemed necessary by the code compliance office. A permit and inspection fee of \$100.00 shall be paid to the county treasurer prior to the issuance of said permit. (Ord. No. 14A-1, 4-22-85)

It shall be the duty of the county administrator to maintain on file in his office at all times a true copy of each ordinance and resolution of the board of supervisors which is currently in effect and which constitutes a part of the regulations of Sanitary District No. 2, and such ordinances and resolutions shall be available to the public for inspection and use during all regular business hours; and it shall be unlawful for any person to violate or fail to comply with any such currently effective ordinance or resolution applicable to either persons or property in Sanitary District No. 2.
