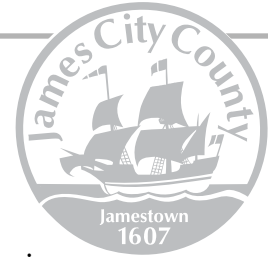

Special Supplement for James City County Citizens 2003 Fall Leaf Collection

General Information



Bagged leaves will be collected in three cycles during November, December, and January by voting districts. Please refer to **voting districts** for your zone and corresponding collection dates. This is the only leaf collection provided by the County. Bagged leaves can also be self-hauled to the Jolly Pond Convenience Center during operating hours (*one coupon per four lawn and leaf-sized bags is required*). General Rules

ZONE 1

Stonehouse District

- 1st cycle November 3 - 5
- 2nd cycle December 1 - 3
- 3rd cycle January 5 - 12

ZONE 2

Powhatan District

- 1st cycle November 5 - 12
- 2nd cycle December 3 - 10
- 3rd cycle January 5 - 12

ZONE 3

Berkeley District

- 1st cycle November 12 - 17
- 2nd cycle December 10 - 15
- 3rd cycle January 12-16

ZONE 4

Roberts and Jamestown Districts

- 1st cycle November 17 - 26
- 2nd cycle December 15 - 23
- 3rd cycle January 12- 16

1. Bagged leaves must be left curbside by 8 a.m. on the first day of collection in your zone. Leaves set out after the first day may not be collected until the following cycle or can be self-hauled to the Jolly Pond Convenience Center (coupons required). Each street in your zone will be collected once during your scheduled week.
2. Bags should be no larger than lawn and leaf-size bags (40 gallons or less). There is no limit to the number of bags you can set out. Bulky materials such as brush and tree limbs CANNOT be accepted.
3. Burning of leaves is not permitted in James City County, except in certain areas zoned A-1, General Agriculture.
4. Bagged leaves are available for commercial or residential composting. If interested, call the Recycling Coordinator at 565-4000.

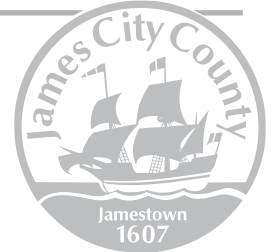
