



2005-06 Leaf Collection

General Information

Bagged leaves will be collected in three cycles during November, December and January. Collection is determined by voting districts. Please refer to the schedule below for your zone and corresponding collection dates. This is the only leaf collection provided by the County. Bagged leaves can also be self-hauled to the Jolly Pond Convenience Center during operating hours (one coupon per four lawn and leaf-sized bags is required). General Rules

1. Bagged leaves must be left curbside by 8 a.m. on the **FIRST** day of collection in your zone. Leaves set out after the first day may not be collected until the following cycle or can be self-hauled to the Jolly Pond Convenience Center (coupons required). Each street in your zone will be collected once during your scheduled week.

2. **CLEAR BAGS ARE REQUIRED.** Bags should be no larger than lawn or leaf-size bags (40 gallons or less). There is no limit to the number of bags you can set out. Bulky materials such as brush and tree limbs **CANNOT** be accepted.

3. Burning of leaves is not permitted in James City County, except in certain areas zoned A-1, General Agriculture.

4. Bagged leaves are available for commercial or residential composting. If interested, call the Recycling Coordinator at 565-4000.

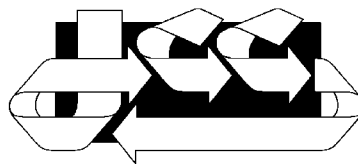

2005 Household Chemical Collection and Computer Recycling Schedule

The final collection date in James City County for 2005 is Saturday, October 8, 9 a.m. - 1 p.m.

- Bring your materials to **Tewning Road** (off Ironbound Road - James City Service Authority employee parking lot). The household chemical collection program enables residents to safely dispose of household chemicals.

Convenience Centers will be closed Thursday, Thanksgiving Day. They will reopen Friday, November 25 for their regularly scheduled hours.

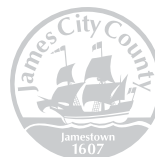
