### Voter Registration:

The deadline to register to vote or change your residence address is Oct. 11 at 5 p.m. Anyone who will be 18 on or before Nov. 9, 2005, is eligible to register. Applications are available at [www.sbe.state.va.us](http://www.sbe.state.va.us), the Registrar's office at 101-B Mounts Bay Road (253-6868) or the Satellite Office at 3127 Forge Road (564-2160). Applications may be returned by mail to P.O. Box 3567, Williamsburg, VA 23187.

### Absentee Voting:

They may be returned by fax to 253-6875, by scanning and e-mailing to [clarac@james-city.va.us](mailto:clarac@james-city.va.us) or by mail at P.O. Box 3567, Williamsburg, VA 23187. Applications for ballots to be mailed must be received by 5 p.m. Nov. 3. Ballots for voting in person are available after Sept. 26 at 101-B Mounts Bay Rd. (follow the signs through the parking lot for handicap parking). If you have difficulty walking into our office, ballots may be brought to your car but please notify us when you will be arriving so we can watch for your car. The last day to vote absentee in person is Saturday, Nov. 5 at 5 p.m.

### Referenda:

**Facilities and Greenways -** Shall James City County, Virginia, contract a debt and issue its general obligation bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$15,000,000 pursuant to the Public Finance Act of 1991, as amended, for the purpose of financing a portion of the cost of the improvements to parks, greenways, trail and recreational facilities?

**Land Conservation -** Shall James City County, Virginia, contract a debt and issue its general obligation bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$20,000,000 pursuant to the Public Finance Act of 1991, as amended, for the purpose of financing a portion of the cost of the acquisition of land and voluntary land conservation agreements that will serve as green space for the County and preserve agricultural, forestal, or environmentally sensitive lands in the County?
