■ ZONE 1

Stonehouse District

Your voting place is at Norge Elementary, Toano Middle or Stonehouse Elementary.

- 1st cycle Dec. 1-3, 2008
- 2nd cycle Jan. 5-9, 2009

■ ZONE 2

Powhatan District

Your voting place is at Christian Life Center, Warhill High, D.J. Montague Elementary or Greensprings Chapel.

- 1st cycle Dec. 3-10, 2008
- 2nd cycle Jan. 5-9, 2009

■ ZONE 3

Berkeley District

Your voting place is at Jamestown High or James City/Williamsburg Community Center.

- 1st cycle Dec. 10-15, 2008
- 2nd cycle Jan. 12-16, 2009

■ ZONE 4

Roberts and Jamestown Districts

Your voting place is at Mt. Gilead Baptist Church, Grace Baptist Church, Clara Byrd Baker Elementary, Rawls Byrd Elementary or James River Elementary.

- 1st cycle Dec. 15-22, 2008
- 2nd cycle Jan. 12-16, 2009

General information

Bagged leaves will be collected in two cycles during December and January.

Collection is determined by voting districts (see left for collection dates with corresponding zones). This is

the only leaf collection provided by the County. Bagged leaves can also be self-hauled to the Jolly Pond Convenience Center during operating hours (one coupon per four lawn and leaf-sized bags is required). General rules

1. Bagged leaves must be left curbside by 8 a.m. on the **FIRST** day of collection in your zone. Leaves set out after the first day may not be collected until the following cycle or can be self-hauled to the Jolly Pond Convenience Center (coupons required). Each street in your zone will be collected once during your scheduled week.
2. Clear bags are required. Bags should be no larger than lawn or leaf-size bags (40 gallons or less). There is no limit to the number of bags you can set out. Bulky materials such as brush and tree limbs **CANNOT** be accepted.
3. Burning of leaves is not permitted in James City County except in certain areas zoned A-1, General Agriculture.
4. Bagged leaves are available for commercial or residential composting. If interested, call the Recycling Office at **565-4000**.

Green Your Holiday Season

- Recycle your Christmas tree! Take it to one of the County Convenience Centers during operating hours. Remember to remove the tree stand and decorations, including tinsel. The Convenience Centers are located at 107 Tewning Road, 1204 Jolly Pond Road, and 185 Industrial Boulevard (Hankins Industrial Park). Christmas trees will be accepted free of charge through February 28, 2009.
- Holiday wrapping paper with metallic dyes, a glossy coating, or imprints cannot be recycled. Try these alternatives: save and reuse wrapping paper, gift bags, cloth bows, and ribbons or make your own gift wrap out of comics or paper grocery bags.
- Recycle corrugated cardboard boxes (limit 12 boxes per week curbside). Be sure to flatten and cut them down to 3' x 4' for curbside recycling, or recycle them at the Convenience Centers during operating hours. For more information, go to jccEgov.com/recycling.
