Hazardous duty service includes service as:

- A member of the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System (VaLORS), including service rendered prior to October 1, 1999, in a position defined in Section 51.1-212 of the Code of Virginia as:
 - (1) a member of the Capitol Police Force (Section 30-34.2:1);
 - (2) Campus Police Officer (Section 23-232);
 - (3) game warden in the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (Section 29.1-200);
 - (4) special agent of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (Section 4.1-100);
 - (5) law enforcement officer employed by the Virginia Marine Resources Commission (Section 9-169);
 - (6) correctional officer (Section 53.1-1), including correctional officers employed at a juvenile correction facility (Section 66-25.3);
 - (7) a parole officer (Section 53.1-143);
 - (8) any commercial vehicle enforcement officer employed by the Department of State Police;
- A member of the State Police Officers' Retirement System (SPORS); or
- A member with special coverage (LEOS/FIRE/SHERIFF) as provided by the employer under Section 51.1-138 of the Code of Virginia; or
- A member of VRS in a position as a law enforcement officer comparable to that of a state police officer, including any sworn law enforcement officer who has the duty and obligation to enforce the penal and traffic laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, as certified by the appointing authority; or
- A full-time salaried firefighter employed by a political subdivision not electing special coverage.
