## **Reservations:**

- Reservations can be made up to 60 days in advance and must be paid in full at the time of reservation.
- Reservations can be made for a maximum of thirty (30) days in a sixty (60) day period.
- Camping fees include pool use and boat ramp for registered guests only.
- Reservations may be cancelled with a minimum of 24 hours notice and will incur a \$10 administration fee.
- Refunds will not be given for any discomforts of nature such as rainy weather, high heat, etc.
- Rain checks must be redeemed by December 31 within the calendar year issued. Refunds will not be given on rain checks.

## **Camping:**

- Quiet time is 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- Unregistered guests must leave the camping area by 10 p.m.
- Registered guests must display parking pass at all times.
- The registered camper is responsible for the behavior of all persons occupying or visiting their site.
- Alcohol beverages and illegal substances are prohibited on County property.
- Two (2) camping units are permitted per campsite; at least one must be a tent.
- Camping rates are per site per night and are for up to six (6) guests with a maximum of four (4) adults. No more than two vehicles per campsite. Additional vehicles must be parked in open area near Bath House #1. Boats and RV's are exempt.
- Using unregistered sites for parking, camping or expansion of your registered site is unauthorized and will incur additional rental fees.
- Utility trailers cannot be used for sleeping accommodations.
- No one under 18 years of age will be permitted to reserve, pay for, or occupy a campsite.
- Camping is permitted only on designated campsites and dry camping is not allowed.
- The person who registered must occupy campsite.
- All trash must be disposed of in a dumpster; on-site trash pickup is not provided.
- Dumping raw sewage or gray water is prohibited.
- Cutting, damaging or removing trees and/or other vegetation is prohibited.

### **Camping continues:**

- Open fires are permitted in designated areas, and must be completely extinguished when leaving immediate area or prior to going to bed.
- Only the current registered guest can make a campfire on their campsite.
- Golf cart operators must possess a valid driver's license.
- Vehicles are only permitted on designated roadways.
- All-terrain vehicles and dirt bikes are prohibited in the park.
- No user shall infringe or interfere upon another's right of usage or enjoyment of the park.

### **Pool:**

- Adults are required to provide proof of residency and age.
- Patrons are required to wear a swimsuit to use the pool.
- Patrons age 12 and under, who have not passed the swim proficiency test, must be directly supervised (within arm's reach) by an adult 16 years of age or older.
- Children ages 6-12, who have passed the swim proficiency test, must have a supervising adult located inside the fenced area surrounding the pool deck.
- Children in flotation devices must be directly supervised, within arm's reach.
- Use of swimming accessories and flotation devices are regulated by pool staff.
- Diving, back dives, flips, running, and rough horseplay are prohibited.
- Infants must wear rubber pants over diapers.
- No glass containers in pool area.
- Persons with open sores of skin infections are not permitted in the pool.
- The use of profanity is strictly prohibited and will result in suspension without refund.

### **Equipment Rentals:**

- The Golf Driving Range closes 90 minutes before the store closes.
- Boat rentals must be returned at least 90 minutes before the store closes.
- Boat rentals maybe cancelled/delayed under the following circumstances:
  - Approaching thunderstorm
  - Thunderstorm watch or warning
  - Hazardous weather outlook
  - Small craft advisory
  - Extreme low or high tides
  - Flooding conditions
  - White caps on the river
  - Water temperature is 58 degrees, or below (canoes or kayak).
- Canoe and kayak renters must be at least 16 years or older; Jon Boat renters must be at least 18 years. Boat renters must be the operator of the boat. Rental boats are not permitted in the James River.

- Renters are responsible for the replacement cost of any lost or damaged rental equipment.

**Fishing:**

- Must have a fresh water fishing license.
- No fishing from boat ramp pier or boat rental dock.
- Unregistered campers may not fish from campsites for more than four (4) hours.

**Rule(s) Violations:**

- Any person violating any provision of the Public Facilities Rules and Regulations, or any park rule will be subject to fine(s) and/or immediate suspension or banishment from use of all James City County parks, facilities and programs.
- Any person receiving more than two notices for rule(s) violations in a 12-month period will lose his or her park use privilege as a registered guest or visitor for up to 13 months from the date of the last infraction.
