GENERAL INFORMATION:

JCC Parks and Recreation Youth Soccer League is designed to be fun and educational. We offer officiated games, but we do not keep standings. The focus is to provide a healthy, fun instructional environment for children interested in playing soccer. Each child will play a minimum of half a game.

Timeframe: March 2012 - May 2012

Ages: Boys and Girls 4-18

Practices: Will begin the week of March 5th - each team will practice once a week in the evening dependent on the coach. Kindergarten teams will practice and play a game on the same day (Saturdays only). If you have not received a call about your team's practice by March 2nd please call Angie Sims at 259-5355.

Games: Games are played each Saturday morning at the Warhill Sports Complex. Games will begin March 17th and end May 12th. No games will be played April 7th. Each team will get a minimum of 7 games.

Equipment: Shinguards are required of each player and must be covered by socks. Jerseys will be provided by JCC prior to the first match. Cleats are optional but are very important and highly recommended. Jewelry of any kind is not allowed during games.

Rain-outs: In case of rain or questionable weather/field conditions, please call the activities hotline at 259-3232. The hotline is updated by 4:00 pm weekdays and 8 am Saturdays. There will be one rain-out date built in for games.

Players will be assigned to teams based primarily on neighborhood school districts. This will bring together friends and classmates to increase FUN and aid with carpooling. Please understand that this may not be possible with all placements due to the number of players, coach availability or practice night conflicts. We will do our best to make it work. Sorry, requests for specific teammates or coaches cannot be permitted.
