

## What Types Of Benefits Can I Receive Through James City County's Financial Assistance Program?

- Discounts are available for qualifying residents for programs offered by Parks and Recreation (including Before and After school programs) and for annual access passes to the James City/Williamsburg and the James River Community Centers. Private instruction courses are not discounted.
- Discount rates range from 15% to 75% based on the applicant's total income.
- Discounts are also available to the Williamsburg Indoor Sports Complex (WISC) and Quarterpath Park—both are County Parks and Recreation partner programs. Discount amounts are the same as those awarded by the County.

## How Do I Qualify For Assistance?

Assistance is based on income and household size. **Please see the Eligibility Guideline Table on the reverse side of this brochure.** Financial assistance is available if you meet the criteria of one or more of the following options:

### Option 1—Social Services Participation

You must be a resident of James City County or the City of Williamsburg and have been approved for at least one of the following Social Services programs:

- TANF
- Medicaid
- Food Stamps
- WIC

### Option 2—Parks and Recreation Assistance

If you do not qualify for assistance from Social Services, you may be eligible for assistance based on your income and household size. You must be a resident of James City County or Williamsburg.

### Option 3—Olde Towne Medical Center

You must be a resident of James City County or the City of Williamsburg. You are required to be approved by OTMC and have received their card.

## How Do I Apply For Assistance?

Pick up a Financial Assistance Application Form from the Social Services department in James City County, the City of Williamsburg, or from any James City County Parks and Recreation facility. Next, submit the application using one of the following options:

### Option 1—Social Services Participation

Complete the application and have it signed by your eligibility or social worker. Drop off the application at any County Parks and Recreation facility or mail the completed application to the address listed below.

### Option 2—Parks and Recreation Assistance

Complete the application and attach a copy of the required documentation (see application for the list of required documents). Mail the application to the address listed below or drop it off at any County Parks and Recreation facility.

### Option 3—Olde Towne Medical Center

Complete the application and attach a copy of your OTMC card. Drop off the application at any County Parks and Recreation facility or mail it to the address below.
