IMPROVEMENT UPDATE (5/28/09)

The pool area and locker rooms will close on **June 15.**

Work is expected to take 90 days, with a targeted reopening on Monday, September 14. Community Center Access Pass holders can also have their passes “frozen” during the closure period. However, “freezing” your pass means you are unable to use either community center or any of the listed swim options during the “freeze” period. Please visit the Front Desk for details.

During this closure period, these are other Pool options:

For Lap and Open Swim

JCWCC patrons will have use of the William and Mary Recreation Center Pool, locker room and sauna from June 15—August 7. JCWCC patrons age 18+ can use these college facilities by showing their JCWCC Access Pass. W & M Swim Hours are Monday—Friday, noon-1:30 p.m. and 5:30-7p.m. and Sundays, 2-4 p.m. Closed Saturdays.

Pass holders can also use James City County’s outdoor pools at Chickahominy Riverfront Park and Upper County Park. Pool operating hours are listed in the Parks and Recreation Activity Brochure and are available at the Front Desk.

Swim Lessons

All Swim classes scheduled for the James City/Williamsburg Community Center will be relocated outside to Chickahominy Riverfront Park.

Water Fitness Classes

Planning is underway to relocate all Water Fitness classes to the Eastern State Pool Facility. For more information on these and other swimming class relocations, call Jackie Condict at 259-4185.

During the first month of renovations, patrons continuing to use the facility will have access to portable showers and temporary lockers. Their continued availability will be determined based on patron usage.
