DIASCUND RESERVOIR

9551 Diascund Reservoir Park Road

This reservoir, provided and operated in joint effort between Newport News, James City County, and the Division of Game and Inland Fisheries, is open to the general public for boating access and fishing. The public boat landing hours of operation are from one hour before sunrise to one hour after sunset. Electric trolling motors are the only motors permitted on the reservoir.

FREEDOM PARK

5535 Centerville Road

This 676-acre park opened in September 2002 and currently includes an entrance road, an open meadow, ample parking, and mountain biking and hiking trails. The site Freedom Park sits on has a rich historical background dating back to the 1600's. The Division continues to work diligently to preserve the First Free Black Settlement in America (1803), the Revolutionary War Battle of Spenser's Ordinary (1781), and most recently, the discovery of a 17th century domicile that is revealing much archaeological research of the early colonial period (1680-1730).

GREENSPRINGS TRAIL

Route 5 behind

Jamestown High School

This three-mile soft surface-hiking trail incorporates an interpretive program that educates trail users by linking historical events with natural features. Trail signs provide hikers with an opportunity to retrace the footsteps of Native Americans and early colonists and to imagine what it would have been like in the New World wilderness. Parking is currently available during non-school hours at the Jamestown High School tennis courts.



LITTLE CREEK RESERVOIR PARK

This reservoir park is a fisherman's paradise and has what your family needs for a fun day. This scenic park overlooks a 996-acre reservoir. Year round fishing, boating, and picnicking are available. The park is open daily March through November from 7:00 a.m. - sunset (6:00 a.m. - sunset on weekends and holidays) and December through February, 7:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. weekends only. The park has a concession facility and a shelter with grills. There are canoes, kayaks, Jon boats, and a launch-your-own-boat ramp.

MID COUNTY PARK (HOME OF KIDSBURG)

Come to this 19-acre outdoor facility that has something for the whole family. For the adults, enjoy our lighted softball and baseball fields, or our tennis, basketball, and sand volleyball courts. For the children, play at Kidsburg, a community-built playground that has become an area attraction. Planning a small family outing, family reunion, or perhaps a group meeting - then you may want to consider Mid County Park. There are two picnic shelters and spacious play areas for games or other functions. The park hours are from sunrise to sunset daily. The park is staffed daily from May 29 - September 6. Labor Day through Thanksgiving the park is staffed weekends only. Access to the park is free and if you want to reserve a shelter or field check out our low fees!

The rental fees are:

- Large shelter - accommodates up to 50 people
Half a day: \$25, full day: \$40
- Small shelter - accommodates up to 25 people
Half a day: \$20, full day: \$30
- Ball field - \$7.50 per hour (two-hour minimum)

POWHATAN CREEK PARK AND BLUEWAY

1831 Jamestown Road

This facility is part of the Chesapeake Gateways Network and provides access to Jamestown Island and the James River. This facility consists of a small boat/canoe launch with parking for 20 vehicles.



SKATE PARK

Located adjacent to the James City/Williamsburg Community Center - FREE

The James City County Skate Park is 10,000 square feet of concrete jumps and ramps. Only skateboards and in-line skates are permitted in the park. We recommend children under 12 years of age be accompanied by an adult. Helmets and protective gear are recommended for your protection. Spectators are not permitted inside fenced area. Hours of operation are from sunrise to sunset daily. Park will close in the event of inclement weather.

**UPPER COUNTY PARK**

This 56-acre park has a 25m outdoor pool, playground, a volleyball court, a basketball court, and picnic shelter that seats approximately 100 people and two that seat approximately 50 people. Admission to the park is free and there is a nominal charge to swim or rent the shelter. The park is open sunrise to sunset. The pool is open Memorial Day to Labor Day
