IV. Updates

Mr. Woolson stated the items done in conjunction with PRIDE were complete. Beth Davis is continuing to work on an informational brochure.

Mr. Ribeiro is looking at information gathered about street width reduction.

Mr. Cleary stated that Mr. Duckett continues to work on the Joint Trench Initiative.

Ms. Cook shared the additional language to be added to the Shared Parking Agreement concerning maintenance.

Ms. Hughes shared information that she received from Scott Thomas in the Environmental Division concerning a locality in Tennessee that has incorporated open space design in their zoning ordinance and stormwater management plan. With regards to Principle #11 this committee will make recommendations to Policy Committee with regards to changing setbacks. It was suggested that Ms. Cook work the the staff on Policy Committee along with the Zoning Administrator to clarify how the change in setbacks will effect new and existing lots.

The meeting ended with an opportunity for public comments. A representative from the Friends of Powhatan Creek was present and commented on the fact the County is pro-active compared to other localities in reference to encouraging open space design.
