

**JAMES CITY COUNTY INVITATION FOR BIDS 10-3752
COLLEGE CREEK 12 INCH WATERLINE CROSSING**

The Purchasing Director or her designated representative will receive sealed Bids for the above titled project at the James City County Purchasing, located at 101-F Mounts Bay Road, Suite 300, James City County Government Center, Williamsburg, VA 23185 **until 2:00pm local time on November 24, 2009**, at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Any bids received after the specified time and date will not be considered.

The work under this Project consists of the installation of approximately 615 linear feet (lf) of 12-inch ductile iron potable water main which includes approximately 340 linear feet of the water line supported on 333 linear feet or pile bent supports constructed from composite piles. The waterline crosses under a tidal tributary of College Creek in James City County.

The services provided by the contractor shall include, but not be limited to, furnishing all materials, equipment, supervision, labor, tools, demolition, mobilization, demobilization, excavation, grading, bedding, shoring, site work, traffic control, erosion and sediment control, bank stabilization, site restoration, testing and disinfecting necessary to install the proposed 12 inch water line in accordance with the contract documents, drawings, and specifications. The project uses the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission(HRPDC), Regional Construction Standards (Fourth Edition) and the James City Service Authority(JCSA) Design and Acceptance Criteria for Water Distribution and Sanitary Sewer Systems, including the Special Provisions..

Contractor registration in accordance with Title 2.2 Chapter 43, Code of Virginia is required. ~~The Bidder shall include in its Bid the following notation: "Licensed Virginia Contractor No. _____."~~

Withdrawal of Bids due to error shall be subject to and in accordance with Section 2.2-4330 (A) (i) of the Code of Virginia and the Contract Documents.

The Owner reserves the right to waive minor non-substantive errors (**informalities**) in the Bid, to reject any/or all Bids, to award any Bid in whole or in part and award the Bid considered to be in the best interest of the Owner. The Owner also reserves the right to negotiate with the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder should Bid exceed available funds.
